SULLENBERGER AVIATION MUSEUM

Immersive experience where visitors of all ages can explore the remarkable stories, innovations, & diverse individuals who shaped aviation history. QUEEN CITY RIDES

Take a 90-minute ride through uptown Charlotte on a eco-friendly golf cart. Carts can hold up to 7 passengers. From its earliest years to the present, Charlotte has had many nicknames, but Queen City Rides simply calls it 'home'.

SOUTHERN CHARM TOURS
